Scholarship Announcement

For the 2011-2012 school year, the Siskiyou Chapter of Women in Timber will be awarding scholarships. The applicants must be graduating Siskiyou County high school seniors who will be attending college or a vocational school for the 2012-2013 school year. Monies will be distributed after receipt of a Verification of Enrollment form (12 minimum units) completed by the proper college or vocational school official is received.

Qualifications

The applicant must:

1. Have a timber related family background *or* interested in a career in the forestry/natural resources field. Preference will be given to those students who have immediate family in the industry.
2. Be a graduating Siskiyou County high school senior.
3. Preference will be given to those students who show an aptitude for meeting varied demands by being active in the community, family business or extra curricular activities while maintaining their GPA.

Requirements

1. Complete the Scholarship Application Questionnaire. Use of additional paper is allowed.
2. Submit an **official** academic record from your graduating high school.
3. **Two** letters of recommendation.
4. A type written statement of not more than two pages summarizing your plans for the future and why you consider yourself qualified for this scholarship.
5. Completed applications must be postmarked by **March 31, 2012**. Applications that are postmarked after this date or are not complete are considered ineligible.
